2. The Abstract should be in a Word Document format, Times New Roman, 14-point font size with 1.5 line spacing, all margins (left, right, top and bottom) should be 2 cm, paragraph indentation 1.25 cm and APA style of referencing.
3. The paper must not have been published or accepted for publication elsewhere.
4. E-Certificate will be provided to all the participants.

The Institute has a strict anti-plagiarism policy, therefore, the authors must ensure originality of the work.

Selected candidates will be informed through mail. The decision of the Review Committee regarding the selection of papers will be final and binding.
